Kinesiology: This degree provides a rigorous program of study combining classroom, laboratory, and field experiences which prepare students to become professionals in the health and fitness industry. A student studies how different exercises and fitness programs affect the human body and learns how to improve an athlete's of individual's fitness levels. Typical job settings include clinical, corporate, commercial, governmental, and community settings.

Physical Education Teacher Licensure: Students must have the following completed when requesting permission (March – Fall classes/October –Spring classes) for first clinical classes at NIU:

- Minimum overall GPA 2.75
- Successful completion ILTS: Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP)

- Negative TB test (tuberculosis). NIU Health Services: NIU student with NIU Health insurance free; NIU student without NIU Health insurance \$10.00 fee
