TRANSFER ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Admission to the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) is competitive and selection for admission depends on space limitations and the overall applicant pool. Transfer students are advised to apply early. The following guidelines are the minimum requirements needed in order to be considered for admission. Meeting these requirements does not guarantee admission.

Transfer applicants must earn a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50/4.00 in 24 semester hours at time of application and 36 semester hours (54-quarter hours) at time of enrollment. Completion of English Composition I and II (or equivalent), Quantative Reasoning and at least one course in Analyzing the Natural World that includes a laboratory at the time of time of application is highly recommended and may be used as a factor for admission.

----- IMPORTANT NOTES -----

- Most course work in the major is expected to be completed after transferring to UIC.
 - After attaining junior standing, all students must complete 60 semester hours at UIC or another accredited four-year institution. Ordinarily, students should not enroll at a community college after earning 60 semester hours.

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***** General Education Requirements *****

To complete the general education requirements for LAS, a minimum of 24 semester hours of credit is required and must include a total of nine courses: two laboratory courses in Analyzing the Natural World, one course in each of the other five categories and an additional two courses from among any of the

six categories. If a course is listed in more than one category, that course may only fulfill the requirement in one category. Up to two courses in the major may apply toward general education. With a double major, two courses from each major may apply toward general education.
